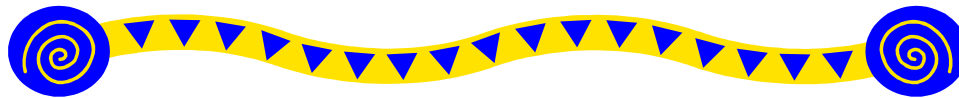

Can I have that recipe, please?



Wind Pie

Filling:

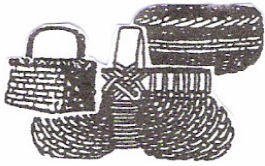
1 small package of lemon Jello
1 cup boiling water
8 oz cream cheese, softened
½ cup sugar
1 can evaporated milk, chilled

Crust:

30 graham crackers, crushed
2 tbsp. xxxx sugar
1 stick butter, melted

- 1) mix the melted butter and the xxxx sugar with the graham crackers, press into the bottom and u the sides of a 9-10" pie pan. Reserve ¼ cup for topping.
- 2) Dissolve the lemon Jello in the boiling water. Allow to cool but not set.
- 3) Cream the ½ cup sugar with the cream cheese
- 4) Whip the evaporated mile until fluffy
- 5) Fold the cooled Jello into the whipped evaporated milk
- 6) Add the cream cheese mixture.
- 7) Pour into the prepared crust and top with the remaining crumb mixture.
- 8) Chill until set.

The filling makes a lot. With the left over filling, you can put it into parfait cups with fresh fruit for a tasty, light dessert.
