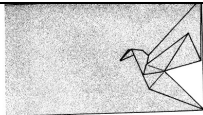
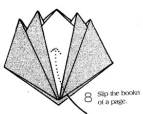
The Monthly Projects, the Terrific Location, Great Food and Friendship - what more could anyone want.

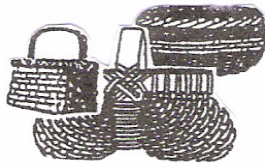
